

**Prince A. Rahming PricewaterhouseCoopers Bahamas** Senior Partner and Territory Leader

2023 Honoree of St. Augustine's College Class of 1986

Prince Rahming is the Senior Partner and Territory Leader of PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) Bahamas.

Prince began his career as an audit associate in the Nassau office of PwC Bahamas in September 1991. Upon being promoted to an audit senior associate he was selected in September 1994 to participate in PwC's Global Mobility Programme and spent the next two years working in the PwC New York office where he was again promoted. He returned to The Bahamas in June 1996 as an Audit Manager and was promoted to Senior Manager a few years later.

In October 2000, he was invited by the Firm to participate in an international exchange programme that sent him to the Lausanne office of PwC Switzerland. The programme was initially slated for eighteen months, however prior to the end date, Prince was offered an opportunity to join the Swiss firm, which he subsequently accepted. On 1 July 2006, Prince was promoted to the position of Director within the Swiss firm, and one year later, was admitted into the Swiss partnership on 1 July 2007.

During his tenure with PwC Switzerland which spanned ten years, Prince was responsible for the audits of the clients with a focus on the financial services industry. He was a member of the West Cluster of PwC Switzerland and worked primarily in the Geneva and Lausanne offices, although certain engagements also afforded him the opportunity to work in other regions, namely in the Middle East. As a Swiss partner, Prince was a lead banking auditor under the Swiss Financial Market Supervisory Authority (Finma), the Swiss Financial Regulator.

As Territory Leader for PricewaterhouseCoopers Bahamas, Prince leads the Firm, which comprises four partners, four directors and over eighty professional and administrative staff offering assurance, advisory, tax and corporate services to clients. In this role, Prince also works along with other PwC regional leaders in the execution and delivery of regional PwC initiatives.



Prince is a past board member of PwC in the Caribbean and became one of the original members of the PwC in the Caribbean leadership team responsible for bringing closer alignment and coordination between regional firms. He is a past Chairman of The Bahamas Financial Services Board; past member of the Judges Remuneration Committee; Member of the American Chamber of Commerce – Bahamas Branch and current member of the Dormant Funds Investment Committee of the Central Bank of The Bahamas.

Prince is a proud alumni of the 1986 graduating class of Saint Augustine's College. He later obtained an associates degree in accounting from the College of The Bahamas in 1988 and earned a Bachelors of Arts Degree in Business Administration from Acadia University, Canada in 1991, where he graduated with honors. He is a Certified Public Accountant and is member of the Bahamas Institute of Chartered Accountants.

Prince is married to Isabel and is the proud father of two sons, Johnathan and Preston. When not working, he enjoys spending time with his family and traveling.
