Justification: Devynne Charlton made history as the first athlete from the Bahamas to hold a World Record at the Millrose Games. Her determination and belief in her abilities fueled her journey to break this record. Prior to her groundbreaking achievement, Charlton showcased her talent on various international stages. She secured a silver medal in the 60m hurdles event at the 2022 Commonwealth Games and further distinguished herself by claiming silver at the 2022 World Indoor Championships, where she set a national record of 7.81 seconds. In 2024, Charlton's persistence and dedication paid off as she shattered the world record for the 60m hurdles, clocking an impressive time of 7.67 seconds at the 116th Millrose Games.
